ATTORNEY GENERAL ANNOUNCES RESIGNATION OF MILLER AS DCI DIRECTOR

CHEYENNE -- Hoke MacMillan, Wyoming Attorney General, announced today that Stephen J. Miller is resigning as Director of the Attorney General Office's Division of Criminal Investigation, effective December 31, 2002.

General MacMillan stated his reluctant acceptance of Director Miller's resignation. General MacMillan said: "Steve's extensive background in drug enforcement, criminal intelligence, and criminal investigation will be sorely missed. I also commend Steve's efforts in vigorous pursuit and seizures of clandestine laboratories throughout the State in cooperation with local law enforcement.

Miller added: "After 25 years experience in law enforcement and nearly 20 years in various positions, I've decided it's a good time to move on to other pursuits. I have had the privilege of serving at one of the most outstanding law enforcement agencies in the United States.
