**INTRODUCTIONS**

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Commissioner Thompson made a motion to approve the minutes for the September 16, 2010, POST Commission meeting. Commissioner Lampert seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**Settlement Agreements**

Commissioner Lampert made a motion to accept the settlement agreement and voluntary surrender of certification in the matter of Alan A. Rehder, docket #10-019. Commissioner Lane seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried.

Commissioner Berry-Smith made a motion to accept the settlement agreement and voluntary surrender of certification in the matter of Benjamin C. Jason, docket #10-023. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Commissioner Lampert recused himself from docket #10-023 the remaining Commission members were all in favor and the motion carried.

**Casper Police Department (CPD) peace officer basic (POB) academy curriculum**

On behalf of the Casper Police Department, Commissioner Thompson advised that the Casper PD would be conducting a peace officer basic training academy which is scheduled to begin January 31, 2011. He asked the Commission to allow a variance in the 2011 peace officer basic academy curriculum to accept shotgun training as an element of the POB firearms training in lieu of the patrol rifle training.

After discussing the request, the Commission advised Commissioner Thompson that patrol rifle training would be required as part of the CPD Peace Officer Basic (POB) curriculum.

Commissioner Thompson assured the Commission that a patrol rifle course would be added as part of the CPD POB curriculum and completed within 3 weeks after the conclusion of the originally scheduled basic.

**OTHER**

Director Haukap reported that the contested case hearing which was scheduled to be heard today has been continued and she is working on setting a new date either the end of April or beginning of May. The next regularly scheduled meeting will be held in September in conjunction with the Wyoming Peace Officer Association 2011 conference in Cheyenne.
