Commissioner Powell called the meeting to order. He announced that the POST Commission would be hearing Docket #07-005. He turned the meeting over to Deb Baumer, Office of Administrative Hearings.

A hearing regarding the matter of Docket #07-005 was heard.

A motion was made to go into executive session.

The meeting re-convened.

Commissioner Emmert made a motion to accept the Settlement Agreement, Stipulation and Order in the matter of Docket # 06-011, James Bieshevel. Commission Dayton seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried. Commissioner Powell signed the order on behalf of the POST Commission.

Mr. Nelson explained the process of adopting emergency rules and that they will go into effect upon the signature of the Governor and are in

effect for 120 days. An extension for an additional 120 days may be requested if necessary.

The emergency rule is as follows to chapter 4, section 10:

Section 10. Detention Officers Working with Juveniles in Collocated Facilities.

(a) Detention officers who work with both juveniles and adult inmates in collocated facilities shall be trained and certified to work with juveniles. The training program shall include, at a minimum, the following areas:

- (i) Youth development;
- (ii) Adolescent physical health;
- (iii) Adolescent mental health; and
- (iv) Nonviolent crises intervention.

Commissioner Dayton made a motion to adopt an emergency rule to the POST Rules & Regulations Chapter 4, Section 10. Commissioner Love seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried.

Commissioner Dayton made a motion to send out the proposed rules of the regular POST Commission Rules & Regulations for public comment as part of the rule making process. Commissioner Emmert seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried.

Commission Dayton made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Love seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion carried.
