

CRIME IN WYOMING

SECOND QUARTER REPORT

2011

The number of Crime Index offenses reported by Wyoming law enforcement agencies during the second quarter of 2011 decreased 11.3¹ percent compared to the same quarter of 2010. Excluding arson, the Crime Index totaled 3,464 offenses during April-June, compared to 3,907 offenses in 2010. A total of 911 Index offenses were cleared during this 2011 reporting period, resulting in a clearance rate of 26.3 percent.

Collectively, the number of violent Index offenses rose 18.8¹ percent compared to 2010 figures. Murder showed no change, with three reported for 2011 and three for the same period in 2010. Forcible rape and rape attempts increased 11.6%, with 48 reported compared to 43 in 2010. Robbery showed a 28.6 percent increase with 18 reported this quarter and 14 for 2010. Aggravated assault rose 20.9¹ percent with 226 incidents this period and 187 for 2010.

Property crimes as a group fell 13.4¹ percent during this quarter. Burglary reflected a 26.0¹ percent decrease with 456 incidents reported for 2011 and 616 in 2010. Larceny-theft showed 10.2¹ percent decrease with 2,590 reported compared to 2,885 in 2010. Motor vehicle theft showed a 22.6¹ percent decrease with 123 reported in 2011 and 159 in 2010.

Arson, a property crime collected apart from the other Index offenses, registered a decrease with 13 reported instances compared to 16 in 2010. The estimated value of property damage related to arson totaled \$99,685 during the second quarter of 2011. Six arsons were cleared, representing a clearance rate of 46.2 percent.

Property stolen incidental to Index offenses totaled \$3,223,161 for 2011 compared with \$4,410,785 reported stolen during the second quarter of 2010. Recovery of locally stolen property was valued at \$918,788 or 28.5 percent of the total reported stolen during this period.

¹The Percent Change figures presented in this report were calculated by comparing the number of offenses reported by each contributing agency while controlling for missing reports. If an agency failed to report crime data for one or more months during this quarter, their data was excluded from this report and the comparison with last year's reports. Given the comparatively low volume of several of the Index offenses, caution must be used when interpreting Percent Change figures since a slight shift in the volume of offenses may result in a large percent change.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE REPORT

The following domestic violence information was provided by Wyoming law enforcement agencies and compiled by the Criminal Records Section, Division of Criminal Investigation, Office of the Attorney General, in compliance with W.S.S. 7-20-107(a)(b) and W.S.S. 6-4-404.

The Domestic Violence Reporting Program, which began January 1, 1988, reflects domestic violence information as submitted by Wyoming law enforcement agencies on a monthly basis. The following tables provide summary information concerning the number of incidents by county, day of week, time of day, type of violence and disposition.

Factors involved which contribute to the amount of domestic violence incidents reported for any one month include: repeated incidents throughout the month involving the same individuals: one offender/multiple victims; and, mutual confrontation where the involved subjects are both victim and offender.

When more than one type of violence occurs, or multiple dispositions are reported for a single incident, only the most serious and/or consequential action is counted for reporting purposes of this program.
